Re: Resident Parking Spaces

We have learned from residents that parking is sometimes hard to find at night on our properties and we are aware that visitors are parking in tenant parking spaces.

It is important that residents advise your visitors not to park in tenant parking areas. We have very limited visitor parking spaces at our properties and when those spots are filled we have no other parking spaces to offer to visitors. Our priority for parking is always our registered residents and in order to ensure adequate parking for our residents, we will issue parking tickets to visitors that are parked in tenant parking areas.

We continue to enforce parking in the driveways and sidewalks at our properties on a daily basis to ensure access to our properties for emergency vehicles and for snow clearing activities.

Starting on January 14, 2019 staff will be issuing parking tickets to any vehicle that has not been authorized to park in the tenant parking area.

Please ensure that your visitors are advised where to park.
